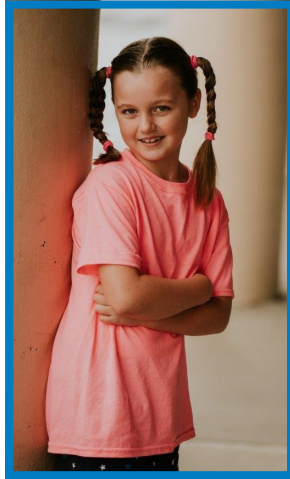




Please Join us in Prayer for Sophie

Almighty God, you gave your only Son into the care of a human family:

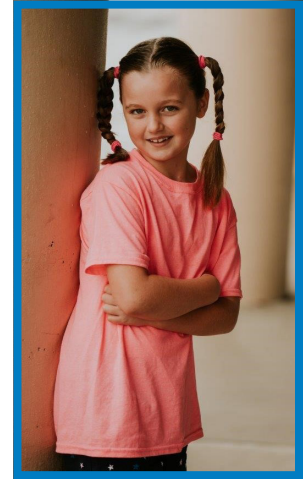
