Please pray that Fernanda finds the family she needs.

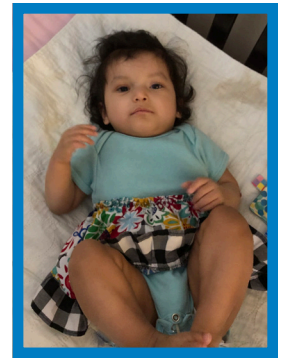
