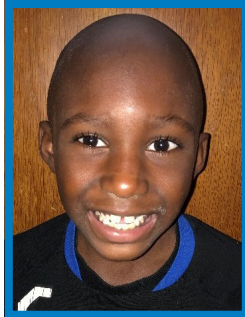




Please Join Us in Prayer for Quavez

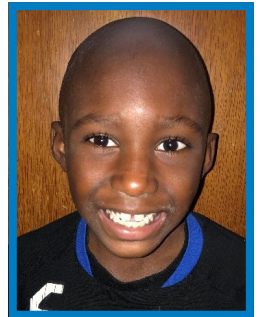
Almighty God, you gave your only Son into the care of a human family:
