

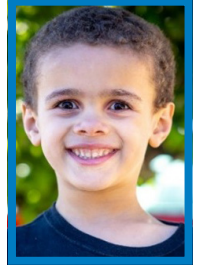


Please Join Us in Prayer for Douglass & Jaycee
