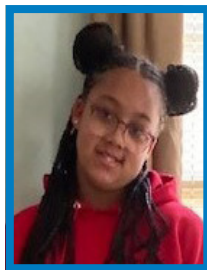


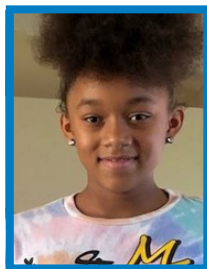


## Please Join Us in Prayer for J'Nay and J'Nette
