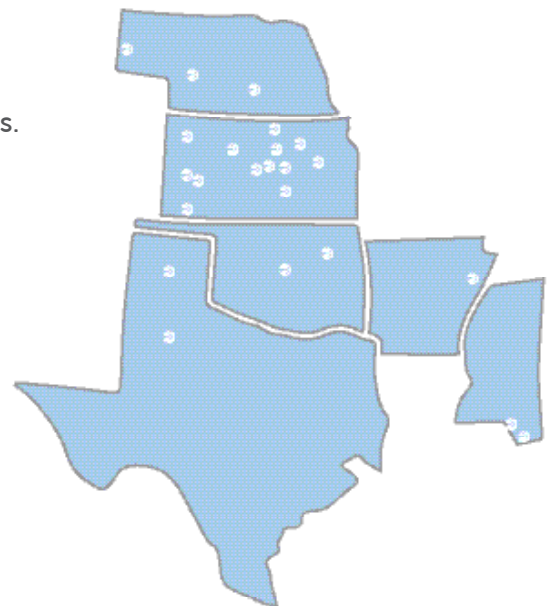


## Saint Francis Ministries Service area
