Why Should You Adopt?

To Adopt:

- You must be 21 years of age or older.
- You can be single or married.

Complete the Assessment Process that Consists of:

- Background checks (criminal, child abuse/neglect, fingerprinting)
- Health assessment
- Employment verification
- Family history
- Budget
- References
- Attend and complete the state required PS-MAPP ([Permanency and Safety-Model Approach to Partnerships in Parenting](#)) training.
