Interested in Adoption?

If you are interested in adoption, but not sure where to start, Saint Francis Ministries can answer your questions, provide information, and explain the process of becoming an adoptive family.

Why Should You Adopt?

If you've thought about adopting a child, know that many children across Texas wait and hope for a loving, caring home. Adoption gives children the love and security they need, a real sense of belonging, and a place to call their own. It's a life-changing commitment, and one that deserves careful consideration.

To Adopt:

- You must be 21 years of age or older.
- You can be single or married.

Complete the Assessment Process that Consists of:

- Background checks (criminal, child abuse/neglect, fingerprinting)
- Health assessment
- Employment verification
- Family history
- Budget
- References
- Attend and complete the state required TIPS-MAPP (Trauma Informed Partnering for Safety and Permanence – Model Approach to Partnerships in Parenting) training.



Children in Need of Adoption

In Region 1 (Texas Panhandle area), there are more than 275 children waiting to be adopted. Children who need adoptive homes come in all ages and ethnic backgrounds, and some have special needs. In our area, more than one in five of those kids are teenagers (aged 13-17).
