(Helping Every Area of

Healthy marriages, healthy families

Project HEART is a transformative, community-based, grant-funded initiative designed to strengthen families by promoting healthy marriages, relationships, and parenting skills, while also supporting economic stability for adults ages 18 and older – both individuals and couples.

The program offers weekly two-hour training classes in a workshop format, available both in person and virtually. Workshops cover marriage and relationship education and skill-building, premarital education, marriage enhancement, divorce reduction, and marriage mentoring, while also addressing disincentives to marriage and strengthening participants' parenting skills.

Our Courses

Core programs: Must be completed

ELEVATE: For couples

(Four 3-hour workshop sessions)

Designed to deepen understanding of human interaction, this course combines practical skills that help couples build and sustain healthy relationships.

TOGETHER WE CAN: For individuals

(Four 3-hour workshop sessions)

This program supports parents as they work together to raise their children by building on personal and family strengths, strengthening coping and stress-management skills, nurturing healthy co-parenting relationships, managing conflict, and preparing for healthy future relationships.

Supplemental parenting workshops:

THE PARENT PROJECT: For parents with strong-willed or out-of-control children

(Ten 2-hour workshop sessions)

Designed for parents of strong-willed or high risk children ages 6 to 18, this program equips families with effective strategies to manage challenging behaviors and foster healthier relationships.

ACTIVE PARENTING: For couples and individuals

(Four 2-hour workshop sessions)

This program helps parents of children ages 0 to 5 develop essential skills to build strong bonds, prevent challenges, and nurture positive behaviors.

CONNECTIONS TO SUCCESS

Participants receive three individual, one-on-one meetings with an assigned case manager. Services focus on economic stability and employment support, based on intake information and program assessments.
