Serving young people ages 6-18, our state-of-the-art residential care campus offers a natural, therapeutic environment where youth can heal, find hope, and begin anew.

Children who come to Saint Francis arrive with a variety of behavioral and emotional issues. Many have experienced complex traumas that can manifest as self-harm, aggression toward others or property, running away, substance use, sexual behavior, and/or legal problems.

We provide treatment for diagnoses that include, but are not limited to:

- Anxiety Disorders
- Depression Disorders
- Bipolar Disorders
- Trauma and Stress Disorders
- Disruptive, Impulse Control, and Conduct Disorders
- Neurodevelopmental Disorder (Including Autism Spectrum Disorder)



Residential Care

Anchored by our Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility (PRTF), Salina West provides compassionate, clinical care for children with both short- and long-term needs.

Recognizing every child is unique, we assess each youth's distinctive needs, adapt treatments, evaluate progress, and achieve results. Our treatment program employs an array of strategies and therapies:

- Comprehensive Psychiatric Services
- Medication Management
- Nursing

- Individual, Group, and Family Therapy

- Substance Use Treatment and Counseling
